*Light and refreshing Spanish white wine made of Sauvignon Blanc and Airen*

### **Il Banchetto Bianco, 2008, Italy**

*Light and fresh apple and peach aromas and a dry, fresh palate. Super easy-drinking style.*

### **Piropo Chardonnay, 2009, Argentina**

**£14.45 / £3.40 / £4.85**

*Intense ripe tropical fruit flavours backed up with soft floral notes and a zippy, refreshing finish.*

### **Operetta Pinot Grigio Garganega, 2008, Italy**

*Light and fresh Pinot Grigio, with hints of pear and almonds.*

### **Saam Mountain Paarl Sauvignon Blanc, 2009, South Africa**

### **Farriers Arms Malbec, NV, France**
